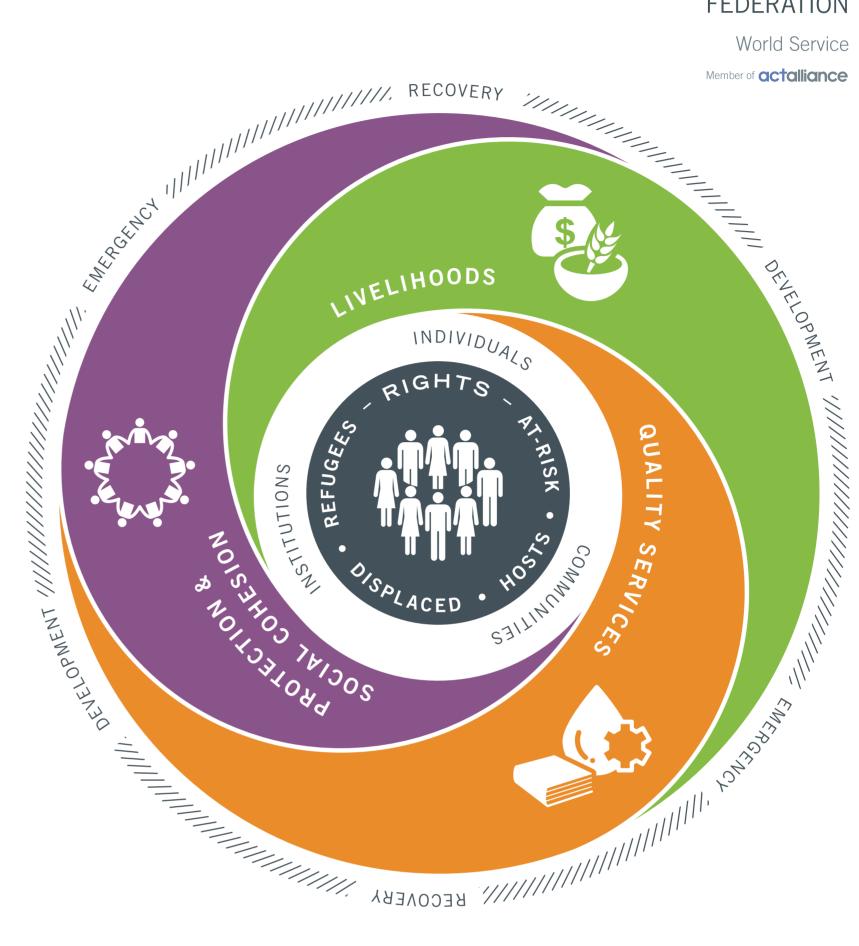
World Service
